## Negri Ruler's sisters to get state's highest award in conjunction with 62nd birthday

**SEREMBAN:** The Yang di-Pertuan Besar of Negri Sembilan Tuanku Muhriz Tuanku Munawir's three sisters will be bestowed with the state's highest award – the Darjah Kerabat Yang Amat Mulia Tuan Raden (DKYR) – in conjunction with the ruler's 62nd birthday celebration today.

Tunku Datin Anne Dakhlah, Tunku Deborah and Tunku Deanna will receive their awards at Istana Besar Seri Menanti Throne Room from Tuanku Muhriz, who is celebrating his first birthday as state ruler.

Two other recipients of the DKYR, who are also members of the Negri Sembilan royal family, are Tunku Datuk Seri Adnan Tunku Besar Burhanuddin and his brother Tunku Imam Tunku Datuk Seri Mahmud.
