



## ANNOUNCEMENT #3 TO ALL INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- 1. The National Recovery Plan (NRP) Phase 1: 1 June, 2021 until further notice With regards to the announcement made by The Government of Malaysia, Phase 1 of the NRP which was scheduled to end on 28 June has been extended indefinitely. This is until the total number of COVID-19 cases reach below 4,000; usage of ICU beds is at a minimum; and the population is 10% fully vaccinated. In Phase 1 of the NRP, the SOPs of the MCO 3.0 continue to apply and selected essential sectors are allowed to operate.
  - 1.1. All international students must remain in their respective localities and continue learning via online platforms. Off-campus students who are involved in research activities that require campus facilities must obtain a permission letter from the Faculty Dean/Director for movement to and from campus.
  - 1.2. Students who have applied for Visa Approval Letter (VAL) are allowed to enrol and attend online classes once the EMGS Approval Letter is issued by Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS).
  - 1.3. International students are permitted to enter Malaysia with full compliance to the rules set by the Government including the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia and the Malaysian Immigration Department.
