

English Holiday Programme

Globalization, frequent flights and affordable airfares make it possible for language learners to travel to Malaysia for both cross cultural as well as English language learning experience. Modelled after UCSI University's English for Tertiary Education programme (R/KJP/00920-00929), this is a short, intensive programme for visitors on social visit to learn English while in Malaysia.

Through this programme learners will be able to practise their usage of spoken and written English as well as to participate in various activities organized to complement their learning experience. Learners will get the chance to make friends with language learners from all over the world and experience the cultural diversity in Malaysia.

1. Entry Requirements

Aged 16 years and above, all learners are required to sit for an English Placement Test (EPT).

3. <u>Course outline</u>

The course aims to develop learners' fluency and accuracy when communicating in English by focusing on the application of the language (listening comprehension, speaking, reading comprehension, and writing).

This is done by exploring various contexts where English is used in formal and informal social situations. A practical approach will be used where learners will be engaged in various context in which target language will be introduced and applied, along with structure and vocabulary.

Before learners join our classes, they are carefully assessed by means of a placement test, so that the appropriate level of study may be assigned to them. Our courses progress through ten levels of academic study from 'Beginner 1' to IELTS Preparation II'. Within each level, learners are tested by various methods in order to provide a system of monitoring student progress and eligibility for progression to the next level of study.

The table below clearly explains the levels that are offered under the English Holiday Programme.

A Certificate of Attendance will be issued at the end of programme to candidates who fulfilled at least 80% attendance requirement

4. <u>Application procedure</u>

Anyone who is on holiday can enroll in the English Holiday Progamme. A valid social visa is the only requirement, other than the enthusiasm to learn and make new friends.

To apply:

- Submit the registration form by post or scan and email the form to the Registry at **Centre For** Languages;
- Submit a photocopy of the first page of a valid passport or an Identity Card (IC), both sides; and
- Pay the prescribed fee, and sit for the English Placement Test (EPT) upon arrival.
