



English for Tertiary Education (R/KJP/00920 - 00929)

The **English for Tertiary Education** (R/KJP/00920-00929) programme is an intensive, ten-level English proficiency programme which immerses students in an interactive, lively and motivating environment.

Students are exposed to functional aspects of language learning. Particular attention is paid to grammar, vocabulary development, pronunciation, and the critical skills of reading, writing, listening, and speaking in an academic setting.

Courses are designed to provide students with maximum exposure to academic English through real life, interesting and current subject matters as well as IELTS mock tests. Upon successful completion of Level 10 of the programme, students are expected to have reached the language competency of B2 on the CEFR, and at least at the equivalency of IELTS band score of 5.5. This programme prepares international students for admission into UCSI University and is approved by the Ministry of Education, Malaysia.

1. Requirements

High school certificate for international students.

2. Intakes

4. Online Application Procedure:

The link will lead you to a 6-Step Registration Process, which takes 10-15 minutes. You are required to provide the following:

Step 1: Establish personal details.

Step 2: Establish parents/guardians’ details.

Step 3: Establish education results summary.

Step 4: Upload the following scanned documents (scan in colour using high resolution):

- i. All academic transcripts.
- ii. Passport (COMPLETE SET, including back covers and empty pages).
- iii. Photograph (Passport size, blue background).

Step 5: Acknowledge and confirm admission.

Step 6: Pay Application Fee (It is generated upon acknowledgement and varies according to the courses).

5. Special features in our English for Tertiary Education programme

Four hours of intensive study each day, consisting of two consecutive, two-hour classes. In addition to these four hours of intensive study each day, students are encouraged to practise speaking and listening English in an international university setting with teachers and students from diverse English speaking backgrounds.
