

English for Tertiary Education

As the world gradually reopens, come join the English Holiday Programme physically at UCSI University. Fueled by the need to keep students learning, the English for Tertiary Education programme (R/KJP/00920-00929), has transitioned from hybrid learning; physical and remote online learning to physical learning. This intensive, eight-level course immerses learners in an interactive, lively, and motivating environment.

Through this programme, learners will be exposed to the functional aspects of language learning through real-life subject matters. Students will also get the chance to make friends with language learners from all over the world while improving their English reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills. Upon successful completion of the course, learners are expected to have reached the language competency of B2 on the CEFR, and the equivalency of a band score of 5.5 in the IELTS. This programme equips international students with a certain English language proficiency level for admission into various academic programmes at UCSI University.

Entry Requirement

Aged 16 years and above, all learners are required to sit for the English Placement Test (EPT).

Course Structure

The course aims to develop learners' fluency and accuracy when using English by focusing on the application of the language (listening comprehension, speaking, reading comprehension, and writing).

This is done by exploring various contexts where English is used in formal and informal social situations. A practical approach will be used where learners will be engaged in various contexts in which the target language will be introduced and applied, along with structure and vocabulary.

Before learners join our online classes, they are carefully assessed by means of a placement test, so that the appropriate level of study may be assigned to them. Our courses progress through eight levels of academic study, from 'Beginner' to 'Level 3'. Within each level, learners are tested through various methods to provide a system of monitoring student understanding and eligibility for progression to the next level of study.

The table below clearly illustrates the levels that are offered under the English for Tertiary Education programme:

A Certificate of Attendance will be issued at the end of the course to candidates who fulfilled at least 80% of the attendance requirement.

The course adopts two collections of books by Cambridge English: the Empower and Mindset for IELTS series, respectively. Lessons and assessments are specifically geared towards the International English Language Testing System (IELTS), the world's most popular high-stakes English language proficiency test for study, work, and migration. Learners will be exposed to IELTS test-taking strategies covering all four test components, helping them to achieve their desired IELTS band score, should they opt to take the test.

Through this course, learners will be able to practice their usage of spoken and written English as well as grammar and vocabulary to complement their English language learning experience. Learners will also get the chance to make friends with language learners from all over the world while improving their English reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills. Our teachers are highly qualified and will help learners build their confidence as well as their English proficiency.
