

STUDENTS RETURNING TO CAMPUS STARTING 15 OCTOBER 2021

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need a letter from the University to return to campus?

All students who would like to return to campus must register themselves with the faculty. For students who require approval letter, approval to return will be given via email within 3 working days.

Is there any arrangement of transportation for students to return?

No, students have to make their own arrangements to return to campus, at the student's own cost, the 3 options available are:

- 1. Drive your own car (carpool with other students are allowed if all students sharing the vehicle are fully vaccinated)
- 2. Fetch by your parent/guardian (parent/guardian must be fully vaccinated as well)
- 3. By Flight

Do the students need to go through 10 days separation before

return to campus?

Not needed for students who are currently in Malaysia. International students who are currently not in Malaysia are required to follow the immigration and Ministry of Health's instruction on quarantine arrangements.

What should I do if I have Covid-19 symptoms after I return to campus?

You may seek medical advice at our Laurent Bleu Clinic or any other medical facilities nearby the campus.

What is the process I need to follow to enter the campus?

All students are required to scan their temperature, check in via MySejahtera and show the Digital vaccination certificate when they enter the campus.

Is it compulsory to use MySejahtera in the campus?

Yes, all students must use MySejahtera to check in and show the digital vaccination certificate when they enter the campus.



Is the shuttle bus available?

Yes, shuttle bus will be available starting 15th October 2021 onwards, please refer to UCSI SAA Facebook Page for latest updated scheduled.

Where can I get accommodation arrangement if I want to return?

A special tenancy arrangement starting 15th October 2021 is available at on-campus accommodation hall, please email to **rhall@ucsiuniversity.edu.my** for booking or further information.

What is the SOP in the campus?

In order to prepare for the return of students, all staff are vaccinated and that the facilities are sanitised on a regular basis. COVID-19 SOPs are strictly adhered to on campus.

All students must adhere to the SOPs by the Ministry of Higher Education and Ministry of

Health at all times within the campus, such as:

- Download the **MySejahtera App** and scan within the campus
- **Check temperature** at the entrance of the campus
- Wear masks at all times and use the hand sanitisers that are available within the campus
- Maintaining social distancing of 1 metre apart
- Minimise movement around the university
- Follow the allocated seating plans
- Do not come to campus if you are exhibiting any symptoms of Covid-19 including fever above 37.5C, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, or flu/cold-like symptoms
- Do not come to campus if you have been identified as a close contact or suspect yourself to be a close contact

What is the arrangement if a resident of on-campus accommodation hall is diagnosed COVID-19 positive?

An isolation room equipped with thermometer and oximeter is prepared for resident diagnosed with positive covid-19, if quarantine at own room is not possible before the transfer to the quarantine centre or hospital.
