Private rented accommodation

Shared houses

Students typically rent shared houses in groups of three to five. Each student has their own bedroom and will share the communal areas such as the kitchen, lounge and bathroom.

You can expect to pay on average £75 to £85 a week sharing with other students. You need to allow approximately £15-£20 per week for bills.

Lodgings

There is the option to live in private houses where the landlord lives on the premises. These can be family households, guesthouses or houses owned by other students.

This is a cost effective and flexible option as all utility bills are included and the accommodation can sometimes be offered with a meal included in the rent.

You can expect to pay around £80 to £90 a week for the room, and £80 to £100 with meals included.
