

## Planning to travel to Malaysia soon? Here's what you need to do.

Congratulations! Receiving this briefing slide means that your Visa Approval Letter (VAL) has been approved by the Malaysia Immigration Department.

At UCSI University, we want to ensure that you have an easy arrival in Malaysia. This briefing slides will provide you with steps to complete to ensure a hassle-free arrival.

## **STEP 1: Clear outstanding fees** (Refer to Offer Letter or Conditional Offer Letter)

## STEP 2: Obtain Single Entry Visa (SEV) (At Embassy / Consulate / High Commission of Malaysia)

## **STEP 3: Arrange accommodation**

You may choose to book and confirm your accommodation through a counselor, representative from your home country, or own resources. Request for accommodation upon arrival may not be entertained due to the unavailability of the preferred room.

## **STEP 4: Apply airport pick-up service**

All new international students arriving in Malaysia are required to apply for an airport pick-up service **seven (7) working days before the arrival date** for immigration clearance purposes.

Airport pick-up is FREE for students with up to two large luggages.

Additional charges:

+MYR50.00/pax for accompanying member

+MYR50.00/baggage for 3<sup>rd</sup> large luggage onward



- Immigration has the right to issue 'Notice of Rejection' and deport students who fail to notify the University before arriving at the airport
- A penalty fee of MYR200.00 will be imposed for airport pick-ups requested less than 7 working days before the arrival date

#### **PAYMENT OF OUTSTANDING FEES**

#### **AIRPORT PICK-UP**

Upon arriving in Malaysia, you will be greeted by a UCSI representative at the immigration office. Ensure you have the representative's name and contact number before you depart to Malaysia.

#### PASSPORT

Your passport must be valid for at least 18 months prior to your arrival in the country.

#### ACCOMMODATION

- For students who have applied on-campus accommodation, be sure to finalise your tenancy agreement, rental fee, check-in date and room number with your counselor or representative from your home country before arriving in Malaysia.
- For students with own accommodation arrangements, inform your relatives or friends to pick you up at South Wing, Block E on your arrival day.

## **OTHER THINGS TO NOTE**

#### **MALAYSIAN CURRENCY (MYR)**

Students are advised to carry some Malaysian cash in case of emergency.

## REPORT TO THE VISA PROCESSING UNIT (VPU) OFFICE ON THE NEXT WORKING DAY AFTER ARRIVAL

Bring along your passport, original education transcript, original education certificate and passport picture. VPU office is located at UCSI University Kuala Lumpur, Block A, Level 2.

#### **INTERNET ACCESS AFTER ARRIVING IN MALAYSIA**

A mobile hotspot service is available in our airport pick-up transportation. Feel free to use this service to inform of your arrival to your family. Selected students are eligible for a UniComms sim card upon arriving in Malaysia. This sim card will be provided at the postarrival briefing.
