

PREVENTION AND CONTROL MEASURES OF THE UNIVERSITY

(Updated 21 Mar 2020)



Should a person suspected to be infected with COVID-19, the institution is to execute prevention and control measures as the following:

- University is to prepare an isolation area / room for suspected patients.
- Move the suspected patient to the isolation area / room immediately.
- Place patients at least 1 meter away from other patients or health care workers.
- Ensure strict hand hygiene for all staffs and suspected patient.
- Provide surgical mask to suspected patients if not contraindicated.
- Personal protective equipment (PPE) as per recommendation should be worn at all times by staffs that have contact with suspected patients.
- Take patients identifiers (name, IC/passport, telephone number, address, recent history of contact points) for notification to Pejabat Kesihatan Daerah PKD (and arranging transport if necessary).
- Patient may use his/her own transport for screening at Lauren Bleu Clinic, or the nearest hospital or district health office (Pejabat Kesihatan Daerah, PKD). Public transport (including bus, taxi, e-hailing) is strictly not allowed.
- If patient does not have private transportation, contact PKD for transport arrangement.
- After the encounter, ensure proper disposal of all PPE that have been used.
- Decontamination of the isolation area and equipment used should be done after patient is discharged.

Criteria for isolation area / room:

- More than 1 metre away from other patients and staff.
- Minimal surrounding items to minimize items requiring disinfecting.
- Single room (door closed) and en-suite bath.
- Availability of food delivery.
- Near to exit/entrance with ease of access for PKD transportation (if needed) – walkway to and from isolation area / room must be less traffic to none.
- Provide tissues/ surgical mask and no-touch bins or biohazard bag for disposal of tissues/ surgical mask.
