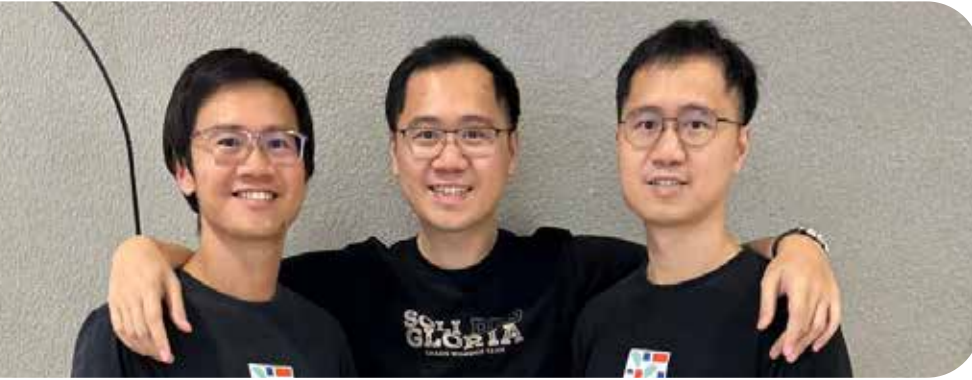
I'm forever grateful to be a full scholarship recipient from UCSI, which not only supported me financially but also provided opportunities for personal and professional development.

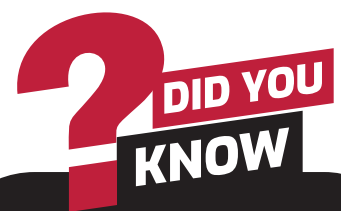

Be a registered full-time student at UCSI University or UCSI College, and satisfy the qualifying criteria and English requirements (SPM, MUET, IELTS or TOEFL, etc.) set by the respective school or faculty for the relevant programme, including any required admission interviews, entrance auditions or placement tests.
2. If a successful applicant does not meet the University or College's English requirements, he/she must undertake additional English course(s) at UCSI concurrently with the undergraduate programme. The applicant will be responsible for the cost of these English course(s).
3. Complete the application form, available at the UCSI University Trust Office (UCSI University/UCSI College) or downloadable from **www.ucsiuniversitytrust.com**.
4. Provide true and accurate information; failure to do so will result in disqualification without prior notice.
5. Forecast results are acceptable if official results are not yet released at the time of the new intake.
6. Submit the scholarship application at **www.ucsiuniversitytrust.com/UG-NewStudent** before the submission deadlines.
7. Late and incomplete applications **will not be considered**.
8. Submit certified true copies of examination results and other supporting documents, as stipulated in the application form, during the interview.
9. **Must not** be bonded to or be the recipient of any other financial aid, award, scholarship, or bursary from other educational institutions or organisations.
10. As the number of scholarships, bursaries, and grants is limited, offers will be made on a **first-come, first-served basis**.

Other terms and conditions

1. For the TSAR Merit Scholarship Award, Sports Bursary and Trust Scholarship, shortlisted applicants will be notified by the UCSI University Trust via email regarding the date, time and venue of the interview.
2. Successful applicants will be informed via email within two weeks after the interview. They must confirm **acceptance of the scholarship within two weeks**, failing which the offer will be automatically withdrawn.
3. The scholarship, bursary or grant is awarded in the form of a tuition fee waiver for the specified programme and duration. It is neither transferable to another candidate nor exchangeable for cash.
4. Successful applicants are required to pay any miscellaneous fees and other charges not covered by the scholarship, bursary or grant. This includes, but is not limited to, the semesterly Medical Plan payment.
5. Successful applicants must sign an agreement with the UCSI University Trust and adhere to all stipulated terms and conditions.
6. Successful applicants must maintain discipline, good attendance and exemplary behaviour throughout their studies at UCSI University or UCSI College.
7. Successful applicants must maintain the following academic performance standards every semester; failure to do so will result in the scholarship, bursary, grant or financial assistance being revoked:
 - a. **TSAR MERIT SCHOLARSHIP AWARD** – Minimum CGPA of 3.75
 - b. **UCSI UNIVERSITY TRUST SCHOLARSHIP / UCSI COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP** - Minimum CGPA of 3.50 (full scholarship) or 3.30 (partial scholarship)
 - c. **UCSI UNIVERSITY TRUST PRE-U SCHOLARSHIP / UCSI COLLEGE PRE-U SCHOLARSHIP**
 - o Foundation: Minimum CGPA of 3.50 (full scholarship) or 3.00 (partial scholarship)
 - o AUSMAT: Minimum average score of 80% (full scholarship) or 70% (partial scholarship)
 - o A-Levels: Minimum average of AAB (full scholarship) or BBB (partial scholarship)
 - d. **UCSI UNIVERSITY TRUST SPORTS BURSARY / UCSI COLLEGE SPORTS BURSARY**
 - Minimum CGPA of 2.50
 - Maintain achievements in sports at district, state or national level.
 - Actively serve and contribute to the promotion of sports at UCSI
 - e. **UCSI UNIVERSITY TRUST EDUCATION GRANT / UCSI COLLEGE EDUCATION GRANT** – Minimum CGPA of 3.00
 - f. **UCSI UNIVERSITY TRUST FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** – Minimum CGPA of 2.50
8. Successful applicants are expected to actively participate in the University or College's sports, extracurricular, and relevant student activities.
9. Successful applicants (except for the UCSI UNIVERSITY TRUST EDUCATION GRANT) are required to voluntarily contribute to workplace and community projects organised by UCSI or the UCSI University Trust (100 SEP points per normal semester, or 50 SEP points per short semester).
10. All information provided must be true and correct. If any discrepancies or false information are discovered, the scholarship/bursary/grant will be withdrawn without prior notice.
11. The scholarship/bursary/grant may be terminated at any time due to gross misconduct or failure to meet the required academic standards.
12. If a successful applicant withdraws from their studies, they agree to repay the amount of the scholarship, bursary, or grant received up to the date of withdrawal.
13. Tuition fee waivers are not cumulative. If a successful applicant qualifies for multiple UCSI scholarships, grants or sibling schemes, only one will be awarded.
14. In the event of a dispute regarding eligibility for the scholarship/bursary/grant, the decision of the Scholarship Selection Committee is final. No appeals will be entertained.
15. The UCSI University Trust reserves the right to determine the quantum and number of scholarships, bursaries, or grants to be awarded or revoked.

General terms and conditions

1. Scholarship application must be submitted prior to the commencement of the applicant's postgraduate studies at the University. Admission into the programme is a prerequisite for scholarship application. Applicants must submit their application forms for prompt approval. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. Shortlisted applicants will be notified by the UCSI University Trust via email regarding the date, time and venue of the interview within two weeks of the submission deadline.
3. While on the UCSI University Trust Graduate Scholarship, all candidates must not be bonded to any other educational institutions or organisations.
4. The scholarship is awarded in the form of a tuition fee waiver for the programme and duration offered. It is neither transferable to another candidate nor exchangeable for cash.
5. All fees and costs not covered by the scholarship shall be borne by the candidate. This includes, but is not limited to, the semesterly Medical Plan payment.
6. All candidates are required to sign an agreement with the UCSI University Trust and comply with the terms and conditions set therein.
7. All information provided by the candidate must be true and accurate. If any false or misleading information is discovered, the scholarship will be withdrawn without prior notice. In such an event, the candidate must reimburse the UCSI University Trust for the total scholarship allocation received (excluding any monthly stipend) up to the date of withdrawal.
8. If a candidate withdraws before completing the programme, all scholarship entitlements will cease with immediate effect, and the candidate agrees to repay the total amount of scholarship received up to that date.
9. In the event of a dispute regarding scholarship eligibility, the decision made by the Selection Committee is final. No appeals will be entertained.
10. The number of scholarships and the quantum awarded are at the discretion of the Selection Committee.
11. UCSI University Trust reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions without prior notice.
12. Tuition fee waivers are not cumulative. If recipients qualify for other UCSI scholarships, grants, assistantships or the Sibling Scheme, they will only be entitled to one—whichever they are most eligible for.

Coursework and mixed-mode programmes

1. The graduate scholarship is awarded in the form of a full or partial tuition fee waiver and is neither transferable to another candidate nor exchangeable for cash.
2. Candidate must be full-time registered students at UCSI University and must meet both the academic and English language requirements. The duration of the scholarship will follow either the minimum duration of the enrolled programme or a pre-agreed duration.
3. Candidates are expected to assist their supervisor and/or the University as a research assistant and/or teaching assistant for a pre-agreed period. The nature of the assistantship will be determined by the dean of the faculty to which the candidate belongs. In the dean's absence, the vice-chancellor will make the final decision on the candidacy and the terms and conditions thereof.
4. At the end of each semester, the candidate's supervisor will evaluate the candidate's performance and make a recommendation on the continuation of the graduate scholarship. Final approval will rest with the dean of the faculty.
5. Candidates must meet the minimum performance requirements set by the faculty each semester. A warning letter will be issued if the candidate fails to maintain the required performance. If the situation persists, the graduate scholarship will be withdrawn.

Research-based programmes

1. The graduate scholarship is awarded in the form of a full or partial tuition fee waiver and is neither transferable to another candidate nor exchangeable for cash.
2. Candidate must be full-time registered students at UCSI University and must meet both the academic and English language requirements.
3. The duration of the graduate scholarship will follow the minimum duration of the enrolled programme or a pre-agreed duration.
4. Candidates are expected to assist their supervisor and/or the University as a research assistant and/or teaching assistant for a pre-agreed period. The nature of the assistantship will be determined by the dean of the faculty to which the candidate belongs.
5. Candidates are required to submit a research project proposal to the respective Faculty within the first semester of their postgraduate programme.
6. Based on the research project proposal, and subject to the Selection Committee's approval, a monthly stipend may be granted to the candidate for a specified duration.
7. Candidates are required to publish their research in indexed journals (Scopus or Web of Science) by the end of their scholarship tenure, based on the minimum duration of the enrolled programme or a pre-agreed duration, as follows:
 - Master's degree programme - Minimum of one (1) journal publication
 - Doctorate programme - Minimum of two (2) journal publications
8. At the end of each semester, the candidate's supervisor and dean will assess the candidate's academic performance and make a recommendation on the continuation of the scholarship. Final approval will rest with the dean of the faculty.
9. Candidates must meet the minimum performance requirements set by the Faculty each semester. A warning letter will be issued if the candidate fails to meet the required standards. Persistent underperformance will result in the withdrawal of the scholarship.
10. Candidates must submit a progress report to the faculty and UCSI University Trust every semester.
11. If a position is offered by UCSI University or UCSI Group, the recipient is expected to commit to working for UCSI for a minimum of one (1) year (Master's degree programme) or two (2) years (Doctorate programme) after receiving official notification from Senate confirming the completion of the graduate programme.
