UCSI University is a top-ranking private university in Malaysia and the only university in the world to make the top QS Recognition for Improvement in 2023. Propelled by its leading-edge academia, the university is renowned for its leadership in academic pursuits and engagement with industry and community.

The university moved up to 63 spots to be ranked 284<sup>th</sup> university in the world and placed among the top 0.9% of the world's universities\*. The university is quickly making a name for itself in research and innovation and has distinguished itself as a higher learning institution with a track record of having quality academicians and researchers with a global presence since its establishment in 1986.

Currently, all UCSI University's programmes have received a 100% employability score from the Malaysian Higher Education Ministry's Graduate Employability 2021 survey, making its graduates highly employable in the job market.

Since 2014, UCSI's top students have been annually selected to advance high impact research at Harvard University, Imperial College London, the University of Chicago and Tsinghua University, among others.

Over the years, tens of thousands of students from 110 different countries have studied at UCSI University, making the campus a vibrant melting pot of culture and diversity. At present, the university runs what is Malaysia's largest university-industry network through its Employment and Co-Operative Placement (Co-Op) programme, which provides employment support services for undergraduates and graduates, including alumni.


