

GLOBAL CONNECT SCHOLARSHIP

As part of the Global Connect Scheme, The University of Queensland (UQ) is proud to offer all eligible students from UCSI University the Global Connect Scholarship (GCS) to pursue pathway programs approved by UQ and UCSI University.

Scholarship details

A 25 per cent tuition fee reduction is available for eligible students from UCSI Faculty Business and Management who commence in a UQ approved credit transfer pathway program for 2024 intakes.

Successful scholarship recipients will also receive a dedicated welcome session and networking sessions each semester, in addition to opportunities to engage in UQ's flagship entrepreneurship programs through UQ Ventures.

Eligibility

To be eligible, UCSI University students must:

- meet UQ academic requirements including mathematics prerequisite and English language requirements
- agree to the Scholarship terms and conditions
- commence studies in UQ's Faculty of Business, Economics and Law via an approved credit transfer pathway
- not hold any other UQ scholarship.

All Global Connect Scholarship offers will be subject to the ongoing approval from their relevant host faculty at UQ. Visit global-engagement.uq.edu.au/gcs-terms-conditions to read the Scholarship terms and conditions.

Eligible UCSI University students interested in a dual degree, where both programs are approved credit transfer pathways, will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Application

All students from UCSI University who meet the eligibility requirements will be automatically considered for the Global Connect Scholarship. Following an issue of a UQ offer letter, students will receive a scholarship confirmation document confirming details and terms and conditions.
